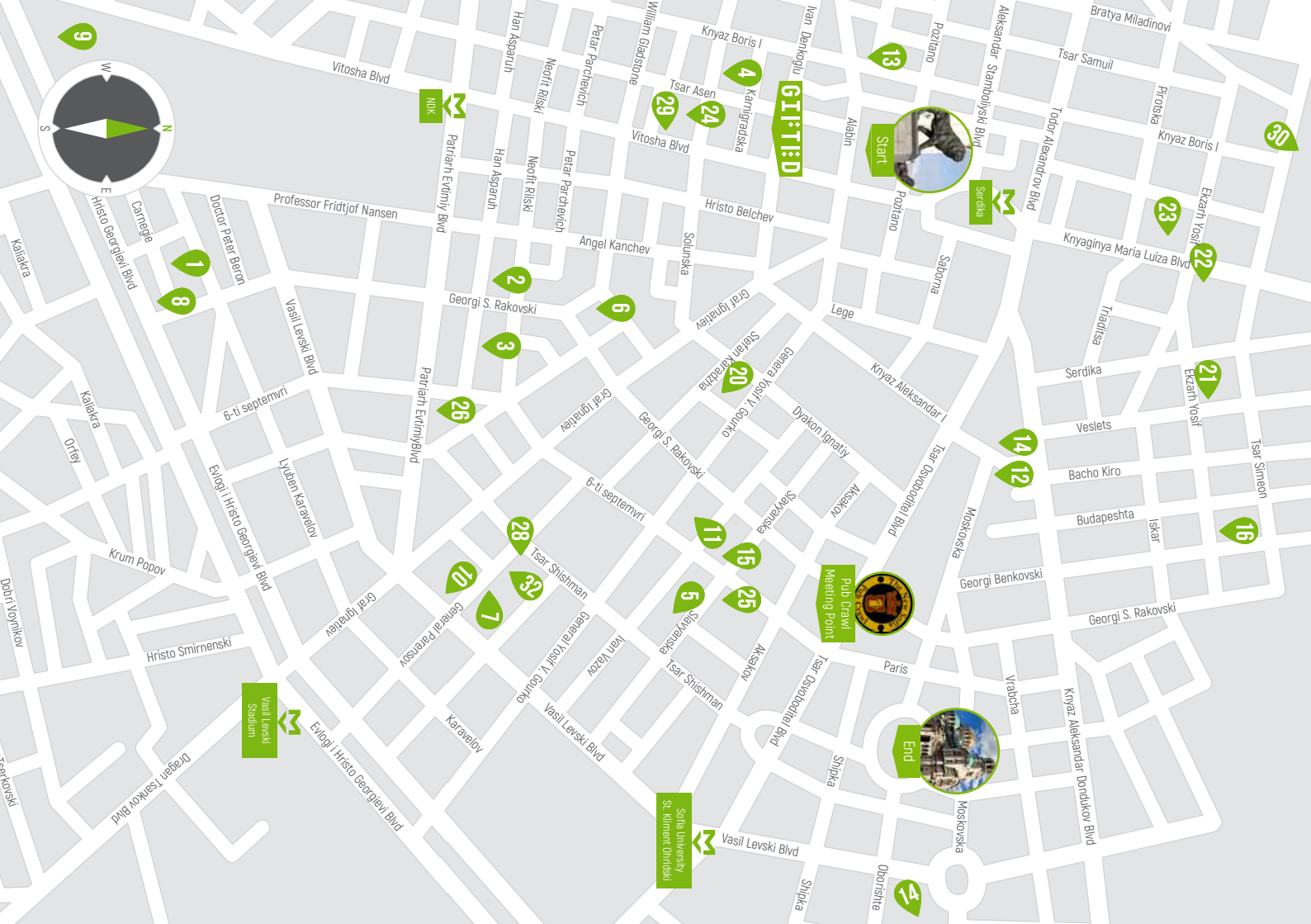

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Pub Crawls Meeting Point

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Hello, dear guest!

We are so glad you chose Bulgaria as your travel destination! We are also delighted that you decided to join the Free Sofia Tour in order to experience our beautiful city!

Now that you got acquainted with our history, we hope you feel more connected to this place! Even though you are now an expert in the history of Sofia, in order to become a true local you need to follow a couple of more steps...

In the next few pages, we have carefully selected local recommendations about the treasures of our city and some practical advice regarding questions we tend to get quite often. Hopefully, you will find the advice here useful, in order to have an even more memorable stay! The booklet is also designed to help you in your quest to become a local in disguise :)

Let's begin!



Here is our bucket list of things to do while in Sofia, in order to become a local:

- Try typical Bulgarian food: banitsa, kebapcheta, bob, shopska salad, tarator, lyutenitsa – the choice is yours
- Taste some local drinks. Nonalcoholic options are ayran and boza, which we usually consume with banitsa. Be aware that most tourists give a very poor rating to the boza drink, since it is quite specific. In terms of alcohol you must try rakia, Bulgarian Mavrud red wine or some of the locally produced beers like Zagorka, Burgasko or Pirinsko.
- Go and party at a local club with pleasure and measure of course! If you still end up with a hangover, you can cure it with ayran or the traditional soup called “Shkembe Chorba”.
- Explore more of Bulgarian nature – visit Vitosha Mountain or go even further and explore Rila – the Rila Monastery and the 7 Rila Lakes are great options!
- Dig deeper into Bulgarian cultural habits by learning how to write your name in the Cyrillic alphabet and dancing the traditional “Horo” dance!
- Visit a local exhibition and buy a locally produced Bulgarian souvenir as a gift! The best place for this in Sofia is Gifted Urban Culture hub!
- Learn more about how communism affected the country to understand the present day political mindset. The Communist Tour and The Red Flat are perfect options when in Sofia!
- Go outside of your comfort zone – visit the local Women’s market, go dine in full darkness in Tenebris restaurant, visit the best cinema in town – The Cinema House, get a tattoo, or try to find your way out of an escape room. We have many interesting options here in the following pages.

Above all, have fun, discover Sofia and come back soon!



Find out what it was like on the eastern side of the Iron Curtain by joining our Communist tour. 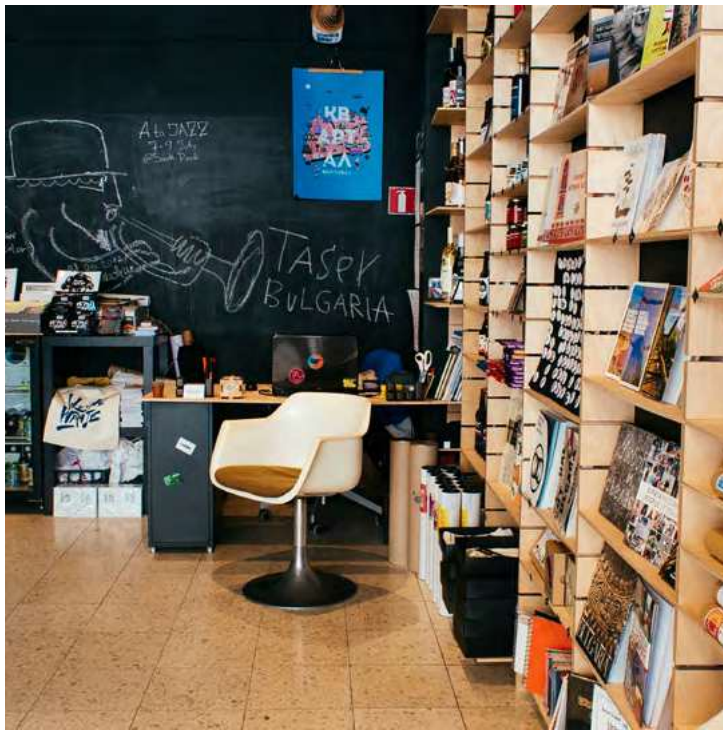

The Vitosha Mountain

Sofia is one of the very few European capitals with such a massive mountain so close to the city center. Its highest peak is the Black Peak (Cherni Vrah), soaring to 2290m. Getting to Vitosha takes anywhere between 30min and 1 hr 30min, depending on the transportation you choose.

How to get there?

Bus 61 is the fastest and easiest way to Vitosha from Sofia's city center. It leaves every 10 minutes under Lover's Bridge (behind the National Palace of Culture) and takes you straight to the Golden Bridges.

Other buses run from Hladilnika/Vitosha Metro Station. To get to the Hladilnika bus station from the city center, catch the second line of the Sofia metro and go to the last stop (Vitosha). Trams number 10 or number 15 can also take you to the same spot, directly from the city center. Then, you can catch one of the following - to Aleko (Bus 66), Boyana Church (Bus 64), Jeleznica (Bus 98), and Dragalevtsi (Bus 68).

By Taxi: A ride to Vitosha should cost you not more than 18-23 EUR.

Unfortunately, none of the Vitosha lifts are currently working.



The Rila Monastery

Just 100 km outside of Sofia you will find one of the nine UNESCO World Heritage Sites in Bulgaria: the Rila Monastery. It is named after one of the country's most revered saints, St. John of Rila (Sveti Ivan Rilski), who was the first Bulgarian hermit, living in the 10th c. and was revered as a saint while still alive.

The Rila Monastery is the largest and most famous monastery in Bulgaria and one of the most significant cultural, historical and architectural monuments in the country. The beautiful murals and icons, genuine historical architecture and scenic nature attract almost a million visitors a year.

How to get there?

We recommend booking a trip to the Rila Monastery and Boyana Church (both UNESCO World Heritage sites) with our partners at **City Tour (you'll find them three pages to the right)**.

To Rila Monastery by BUS:

Ever since the pandemic started the public bus to the Rila Monastery has not been operating. Please call Ovcha Kupel bus station for the most up to date information on the current schedules.

To Rila monastery by CAR:

The most convenient way to travel in Bulgaria in general. If you can use a car (rented or borrowed), do not hesitate. This would give you much more speed, freedom and chance to stop by less obvious but as interesting tourist attractions. For example, you can see the unofficial 'junk' museum just outside of Kocherinovo. Retro cars, old TV sets, photos of Lenin and hundreds of other old items.



Plovdiv

You must not leave Bulgaria before visiting at least one other place. Our best recommendation is the ancient city of Plovdiv with its own unique spirit and character. Located just about 120 km away from Sofia on the banks of the Maritsa river, the hilly city will strike you with its history and its fast (re) establishment as a cultural center. A city, bearing the motto 'Ancient and Eternal', and former European Capital of Culture, surely has a lot to offer. Once in Plovdiv, the Free Plovdiv Tour will introduce you to the city and its millennia-long history.

How to get there?
